Our Program

The Greenfield-Central Drama Program is proud to be a part of the G-C Cougar Community. Our Department works extremely hard all year to provide Broadway quality entertainment to the school and community. Students are involved all year long in perfecting their craft. Many attend numerous camps, classes, and workshops to enhance their skill set.

A New Start

Of course the department has had incredible support from families and businesses in the past. Now the 2016-2017 G-C Drama Boosters has had both a new structure and some new directives. One of the most important is our recent recognition as a 501(c)(3) organization. With this status we can help our department raise necessary funds and provide a tax-deductible option to families and businesses.

Funding

Production rights (that is what we pay just to be allowed to put on a show) average between \$4,000 – 6,000 per production. This can consume all production fee and ticket sales profits. To actually produce an entire show, G-C Drama must raise the rest of the funds to cover the cost of set construction, building materials, special effects, rentals, hair, make-up, costumes, orchestra, and additional costs that easily add up to another \$10,000-20,000. With a goal of including as many students as possible and producing 4+ shows per year, the costs far exceed the budget.
